




# Parish Matters



<p><b>Aim</b></p>	<p>This course provides attendees with the opportunity to focus on parish matters, covering a wide range of parish topics and providing a comprehensive, practical guide.</p>
<p><b>Objectives</b></p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To establish the different parish areas, and electoral arrangements.</li> <li>2. To understand the procedures and key stages involved in a community governance review.</li> <li>3. To equip delegates with an understanding of key election processes such as candidate nominations, receiving thousands of nomination papers and reconciling multiple vacancy counts.</li> <li>4. To create an awareness of how to deal with casual vacancies, co-options and inquorate parish councils.</li> <li>5. To establish the rules around parish meetings and parish polls.</li> </ol>
<p><b>Audience</b></p>	<p>This course is for anyone dealing with parish council elections, vacancies, councillors' qualifications and the briefing or advising of parish clerks.</p>

<b>Course Overview</b>	<p>This one-day course will be wide ranging, covering topics such as parish electoral arrangements, councillors qualifications, the differences between parish council and other elections, parish council casual vacancies, parish meetings and parish polls.</p> <p><b>Please note:</b> Although many aspects of parish elections will be touched on, this course is not intended to cover the delivery of elections in great detail.</p> <p>The Course will be delivered using a mixture of presentational material, practical exercises and reference to example documentation and official guidance.</p> <p>Group discussion will also take place during the day to enable the exchange of knowledge, experience and ideas.</p> <p><b>All attendees will receive their own invaluable (updated) reference manual for future use.</b></p> <p>Each course runs from 10am until 4pm with breaks for lunch as well as tea and coffee.</p>
