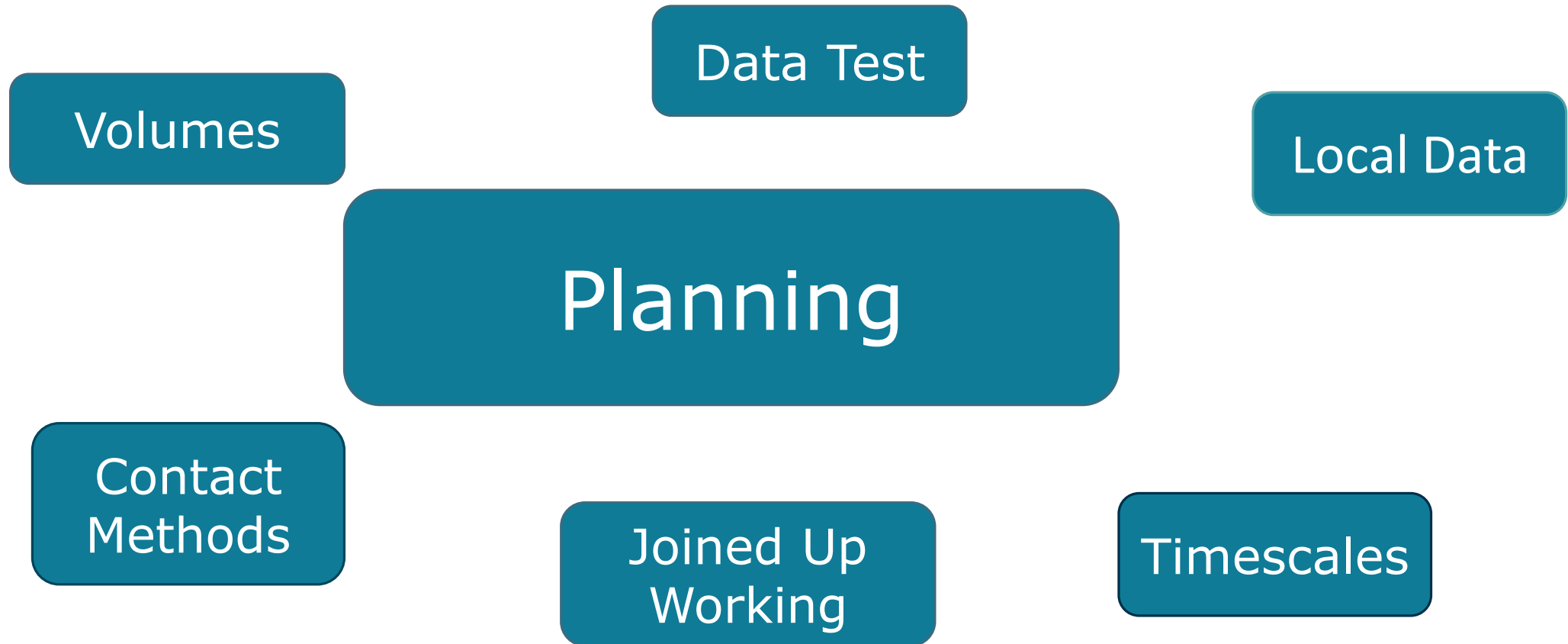

Working with Stakeholders

- Help promote registration
- Access to additional data sources
- Scotland – Universities, Care Homes & Schools, in future Prisons..
- Toolkits
- Requires patience, particularly with Data Sharing Agreements
- Benefits of Regulation 23
- “A registration officer may require any person to give information required for the purposes of that officer’s duties in maintaining registers of parliamentary and local government electors”

Year Round Activity

- Pilots showed that HNLs (Route 1) were less effective in identifying change.
- Cabinet Office “The MI data shows there was less overall change recorded, suggesting that the quality of the electoral register is likely to be lower.
- Electoral Commission “ Registers....would over time become less accurate & complete”
- Important that matching for Route 1 is accurate
- New additions – Scotland & Wales – Franchise Change
- Supplement with year round data mining
- Local “Churn” levels”
