



# Parish Matters

## Aim

This comprehensive and practical course will allow attendees to focus on specific legislation, rules and scenarios that apply to parish councils, also called town or community councils in some areas.

## Objectives

1. Establish different parish areas and electoral arrangements.
2. Understand procedures and key stages involved in a community governance review.
3. Equip delegates with an understanding of key election processes such as candidate nominations, receiving thousands of nomination papers and reconciling multiple vacancy counts.
4. Create an awareness of how to deal with casual vacancies, co-options and inquorate parish councils.
5. Establish the rules around parish meetings and parish polls.

## Who is this course for?

This course is for anyone dealing with parish council elections, vacancies, councillors' qualifications, and the briefing or advising of parish clerks.

## Course Overview

You will cover a wide range of topics such as parish electoral arrangements, councillors qualifications, the differences between parish council and other elections, parish council casual vacancies, parish meetings and parish polls.

**Please note: Although many aspects of parish elections will be touched on, this course is not intended to cover the delivery of elections in detail.**

The course will be delivered online using a mixture of presentation material, practical exercises, with reference to example documentation and official guidance.

Group discussion will take place during the day to enable you to exchange knowledge, experience and ideas.

All delegates will receive their own invaluable reference manual for future use.

Each course runs from 10:00 until 16:00 with breaks for lunch and for tea and coffee.
