



Two Day Elections

Aim

To provide delegates with a comprehensive understanding of managing an election, including the legislative framework and good practice.

Objectives

1. Define the legal requirements that govern election administration and the duties of the different types of Returning Officer.
2. Outline the framework for both by-elections and scheduled polls, including timetables, nominations, poll cards and postal voting.
3. Consider other aspects of an election such as polling day organisation, the count and post-election procedures.
4. Explore good practice relating to all aspects of election management.

Who is this course for?

This course is designed for people with a good knowledge of election administration, but who are looking for a more comprehensive understanding of processes and want to identify ways to improve service delivery. This course is also recommended as a revision tool for candidates studying for our Certificate in Electoral Administration.

The course will be delivered using a mixture of presentation material and exercises, with reference to example documentation and official guidance.
