

Votes in STV Elections are Cast in the Traditional Way...





Electoral Reform – Scottish Devolved Elections

Votes at 16 in Scotland 2014-2021 study - led by Jan Eichhorn of the University of Edinburgh, School of Social and Political Science, 16 Jan 2023

Key findings:

- Voter turnout is higher among those who first voted from the age of 16 or 17.
- The younger voting age has had no long-term effects on other forms of political engagement, such as demonstrations or petitions.
- Standard voting inequalities related to characteristics such as socio-occupational class re-emerge as people get older.
- Political engagement of those aged 16 to 31 is largely affected by their family contexts.
