



Elections 2024

Aim

To focus on key points to consider to ensure efficient and effective organisation of scheduled elections in May 2024.

Objectives

1. Define the legal requirements that govern election administration and the duties of the different types of Returning Officer.
2. Outline the framework governing both by-elections and scheduled polls, including timetables, nominations, poll cards and absent votes.
3. Consider aspects including polling day organisation, the count(s) and post-election procedures.
4. Explore good practice relating to all aspects of election management.

Who is this course for?

This course is designed for experienced administrators who want to refresh their knowledge and exchange good practice. It is also suitable for inexperienced staff, including managers, who would benefit from a good overview of election organisation.

Course overview

You will cover all main election procedures in addition to any new or topical arrangements. The course provides guidance across all election elements, allowing new staff an overview and providing a refresher for experienced staff. It will help you to identify efficient and effective organisation and exchange good practice examples.

Note: this course will touch on the new requirements introduced by the Elections Act – that will be in place for May 2024. However, the new requirements are not the sole focus of this course, which covers delivery of the election as a whole.

The course will be delivered using a mixture of presentation material and reference to example documentation and official guidance.

Discussion will be encouraged to enable you to exchange knowledge, experience, and ideas.

You will be provided with a course pack prior to the course.
